Institution must provide robust ethics training and enforce clear policies on body

use. Transparency and public engagement are crucial for trust and informed consent. Going forward, we need international standards and continuous ethical review to navigate this complex landscape."

Other speakers including Prof. Dr. M. Eltohami Abdel Magid, Dr. Chea Pike-See, Dr. Micheal KH Ling shared their latest research and evidence-based practices.

In addition, there was a special session in which lifetime achievement awards were presented to Prof. Dr. Nasra Hyder Kazi, Prof. Amir Ali Shoro, Prof. Dr. Attiya Mubarak Khalid and Prof. Dr. Nosheen Omer to acknowledge their exceptional contributions to the field of anatomy.


